Hay will be available for purchase at the market price at the field trial grounds. Park your vehicles in the designated areas. Dogs and Horses may be staked out in the designated areas. Please be courteous and clean up your area before leaving. Thanks for your help in making this a successful trial.

DOG WAGON

We will be using a dog wagon for the Classic at the Morton Ranch. Handlers are responsible for loading their dog on the dog wagon. We plan to load three braces at a time so we will need your cooperation to make sure the right dog is loaded in the wagon.
