NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AND NATIONAL AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP – Open to any AKC registerable Irish Setter that is six months of age or over on the first advertised start date of the trial and that has either placed 1st in an ISCA Futurity, or 1st in a derby stake, or 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th in a Gun Dog or All Age stake at an AKC Licensed or AKC Member Field Trial on or before October 23, 2004. All dogs entered in the National Championship and/or the National Amateur Championship are required to have an AKC DNA profile AND be microchipped. Dogs will NOT be drawn for these stakes unless DNA and chip information is sent with entries or is on file with the Field Trial Secretary prior to drawing.

ISCA FUTURITY – Open to properly nominated Irish Setters of ISCA members. Starting with the 2004 Futurity, an AKC DNA profile and microchip will be required. Dogs will NOT be drawn unless this information is sent with entries or is on file with the Field Trial Secretary prior to drawing.

OPEN DERBY – Open to Irish Setters only.

ENTRIES WILL CLOSE AT 6:00 PM (PST), Friday, OCTOBER 15, 2004 with the Field Trial Secretary at 2430 Shoreline Dr., Napa, CA 94558. Entries must be received on or before October 15, 2004, but dogs will have until October 23, 2004 to meet the placement qualification for the National Championship and/or the National Amateur Championship as indicated above.

DRAWING WILL TAKE PLACE AT 7:00 PM (PST), Friday, OCTOBER 15, 2004 at 2430 Shoreline Dr., Napa, CA 94558. Dogs with pending placement qualification status will be drawn with all other entries in the National Championship and/or National Amateur Championship and pulled/scratched on October 24, 2004 with full refund should they not qualify. Please issue separate checks payable to ISCA for dogs needing a placement to qualify for the National Championship and/or National Amateur Championship. Advise Field Trial Secretary as soon as status is known.
